A Model for Enterprise Information System Security

Organizations around the world utilize information technology ecosystem to manage and operate their business. Typically, such a system is known as an Enterprise Information System (EIS) which links the various entities of the business for efficient management on a global basis. During the past few decades, business systems have been breached by internal and external actors. To combat this threat, organizations have started to pay more attention on the development and implementation of the security component module associated with their EIS. Furthermore, this EIS Security structure needs to be monitored through the corporate governance of the firm. This presentation will focus on a model which was developed through a comprehensive literature review. We identified four key pillars of a model for EIS Security. These pillars are Security Policy, Security Awareness, Access Control, and Top Level Management Support. We explore the relevance of this model using a case study approach by way of interviewing top-level information systems managers in the banking sector as well as other sectors. We validate the model through using key informant in-depth interviews and qualitative research methods.

Sohail S. Chaudhry is a Professor of Operations and Supply Chain Management at Villanova School of Business, Villanova, Pennsylvania, USA. He received his Ph.D. in Industrial Engineering and Operations Research from Columbia University, New York. His research and teaching interests are in the areas of Operations and Supply Chain Management and Information Systems. He has published over seventy papers in journals such as Annals of Operations Research, Computers & Operations Research, Decision Sciences, Electronic Markets, Enterprise Information Systems, Expert Systems, European Journal of Operational Research, Information System Frontiers, International Journal of Production Research, Management Science, and Systems Research and Behavioral Science. At the professional level, Professor Chaudhry serves as a member on the Editorial Advisory Boards of several international journals including as an Associate Editor of Enterprise Information Systems and Journal of Industrial Integration and Management. He has co-edited five books related to Enterprise Information Systems for Springer and CRC Press. Furthermore, he has given over eighty paper presentations at conferences and universities around the world. In addition, he had held visiting faculty positions at American University in the Emirates, UAE; Beijing Jiaotong University, China; DIS Denmark, Denmark; European Business School, Germany; Hebei University of Science and Technology, China; Institut Suprieur de Gestion de Sousse, Tunisia; Institut Teknologi Bandung, Indonesia; Korea University, Korea; and Temple University, Japan.
